#### THE TOMODACHI-UNIQLO FELLOWSHIP

The TOMODACHI-UNIQLO Fellowship provides financial support for a student from Japan who is enrolled in the MFA Fashion Design & Society program. This fellowship is possible due to the generous support of the U.S. Japan Council and Uniqlo - This fellowship is administered by U.S. Japan Council, and made it possible due to the generous support of Fast Retailing Co. Ltd.

The TOMODACHI-UNIQLO Fellowship is open to applicants from Japan and provides financial support of up to \$150,000, to the full cost of attendance for both tuition and living expenses for the two-year program. The amount awarded is based on the student's financial need. In addition, the fellowship recipient has the opportunity to participate in an internship at Fast Retailing Co., Ltd. during the summer after his or her first year in the program.

#### **ELIGIBILITY AND PROCESS**

The TOMODACHI-UNIQLO Fellowship seeks candidates who meet the following criteria:

- Completed the majority of their education in Japan
- Is a Japanese National
- Have demonstrated financial need
- Have demonstrated leadership skill

To be considered, individuals must apply and be accepted to Parsons' MFA Fashion Design and Society program. Parsons will review all eligible applications for scholarship consideration and select a recipient on the basis of the criteria listed above.
